Town Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Al Rosenthal Called the meeting to order at 5:30 for the Hearing to discontinue that portion of Lake Street lying West of Lakeshore Drive to its terminus at Buffalo Lake, located in the Town of Packwaukee, Marquette County.

Motion by Vikki Trimble seconded by Joe Oravetz to approve to discontinue Lake Street lying West of Lakeshore Drive to Buffalo Lake. Motion Carried.

Meeting Minutes: Motion by Vikki Trimble seconded by Jim Sanders to approve the July 11, 2017 minutes as they are written. Motion Carried.

Treasurers Report: Treasurer Jeri Showers read the Treasurers report.

Library: Summer programs are going great. Book sale went well. The left over books have been donated to a correctional institute. Broken window in Library is being fixed.

Citizens Inquiries and Concerns: The tree that is leaning toward a house on Stockyard Road is the property owners business.. Board has nothing to do with it. Complained about lot needing mowing on corner of Lake St. and State St. This lot will be mowed this week. Cheryl Bergmann asked if the Town could fix a retaining wall. This retaining wall is on her property so the town has no responsibility for it.. although the rocks she placed on the roadside may need to be removed. Mowing of Skibbies has been done by them. Mowing of property on 8th Lane letter sent.

Recycling Center: Motion by Lance Achterberg seconded Vikki Trimble to pay Gary Sanders \$850.00 for the sheds at the recycling Center. Motion Carried. 1 No 3 yes 1 abstained.

Cemetery: Complaint on large pine tree in Oak Hill Cemetery it is very messy and maybe should come down. Lance Achterberg will check on this pine tree.

Roads: Bid for the Causeway came in lower than expected. Braking sign area sent to Department of Transportation.
