## SEC. 7-3-1 PHARMACISTS' PERMITS.

- (a) A Pharmacist's Permit, when issued by the Town Clerk in and upon compliance with this Code and the Wisconsin Statutes, shall entitle and authorize the holder thereof to possess, sell or offer for sale intoxicating liquors as defined by Sec. 125.02, Wis. Stats., in quantities less than four (4) liters for medicinal or scientific purposes only and not to be drunk on the premises. Said sales shall be made in compliance with Sec. 125.57, Wis. Stats.
- (b) Upon the approval of the application by the Town Board, the Town Clerk shall, upon filing by the applicant of a receipt showing the payment to the Town of a permit fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00), issue to the applicant a permit.
- (c) Each permit shall be numbered in the order in which issued and shall specifically state the premises for which issued, the fee paid and the name of the licensee.

## SEC. 7-3-2 CIGARETTE LICENSE.

- (a) **License Required.** No person, firm or corporation shall, in any manner, directly or indirectly, upon any premises, or by any device, sell, exchange, barter, dispose of or give away, or keep for sale, any cigarette, cigarette paper or cigarette wrappers, or any substitute therefore, without first obtaining a license as hereinafter provided.
- (b) Application for License; Fee. Every person, firm or corporation desiring a license under this Section shall file with the Town Clerk a written application therefore, stating the name of the person and the place for which such license if desired. Each license shall be filed by the Town Clerk and shall name the licensee and the place wherein he is authorized to conduct such business, and the same shall not be delivered until the applicant shall pay to the Town Clerk a license fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00)
- (c) Issuance and Term of License. Licenses for the sale, exchange, barter, disposition of, or giving away or keeping for sale of cigarette paper or cigarette wrappers or any substitute therefore shall be issued by the town Clerk. Each license shall be issued on the first day of July in each year, or thereafter whenever applied for, and shall continue in force from date of issuance until the succeeding June 30<sup>th</sup> unless sooner revoked for any violation of this Section.
