Town Board Meeting

Chairman Neil Johnson called meeting to order at 6:00 pm
Pledge of allegiance

Meeting Minutes: Motion by Paul Sanders seconded by Jim Sanders to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2010 Town Board Meeting as written. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's report: Motion by Jim Sanders seconded by Vikki Trimble to approve the treasurers report as read. Motion Carried.

State Rep. Fred Clark: visited and talked about different information on Marquette County. Discussed Causeway but Board needs to set up a plan.

Citizen Inquiries and Concerns: June Schumacker, project director for Marquette County's Hidden History Mural Project presented a presentation on barn quilts and murals.

Letters sent to several different properties about lawn mowing, and many have been mowed. Mrs. Swoboda asked the Board if some plants, bushes or trees could be planted in front of the outside restrooms to make them look nicer for her view. She would also like the Board to check into the ally being vacated and the culvert of her neighbors as it is not draining properly. Vikki Trimble is working on the culvert and Neil Johnson is working on the ally. Paul Sanders will check what the Board could do for the restrooms.

Cemetery: Motion by Vikki Trimble seconded by Paul Sanders to approve an extra \$150.00 for the driveway gravel and work at Oak Hill Cemetery. Motion carried.
