

**April 20, 2021**  
**Town of Packwaukee**  
**Annual Town Meeting**

Called to Order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Lance Achterberg

- Decision made to vote by hand - 22 residents attending.
- Motion by John Bluemke, seconded by Al Rosenthal to approve the minutes of the April 21, 2020 and May 12, 2020 annual meetings. Motion carried 22-0
- Treasurer's annual 2020 tax roll report read
- Clerk's 2020 financial report presented.
- Citizens Inquiries and Concerns:
  - Motion by Al Rosenthal, seconded by Kathy McReath to direct the town board to hire an accountant to review the financial books and procedure, money to come from the 2022 budget. Discussion. Al Rosenthal amends motion that a report should be given at the 2022 annual meeting, Kathy McReath seconds amended. Motion carried 20-0-2.
  - Janny Slama presents concerns with the disarray of the meeting room during a recent rental and the fact that the town vacuum does not work anymore.
  - Janny Slama is concerned that the gravedigger did not place sod over a recent grave.
  - Janny Slama expressed concern that the recycling center looks messy with all the items sitting around.
  - Keith Bagley states the Presbyterian Church is organizing a city wide rummage sale for May 15th.
  - Janny Slama would like a stop sign with a "right turn no stop" sign on County C at the intersection with 8th. Jeri Showers adds that she would like the speed limit to be lowered on this section of County C.
  - Marcia Lee is concerned that salting/sanding of 8th road to the recycling center is not being done well enough or earlier enough in the winter.
  - Frank Behling expressed concern that when the county plows snow they are ripping up front lawns.
  - Linda Huggett asks for clarification on what plastics are recyclable. Per Lance, everything with a diamond and number is recyclable. Styrofoam is not recyclable.
  - Marcia Lee suggests some sort of notification/postcard to all residents regarding the recycling center and the procedures for recycling and dumping trash.
  - Marcia Lee inquires whether there is any plan to expand the town hall/library. Vikki Trimble suggests we look into available COVID-19 grants to see if there is any money available for this.
  - John Bluemke received a call from Tom Onofrey that a company has approached a land owner and the county regarding putting in a sand and gravel pit on County D in Packwaukee near County K. There is not a lot of information available about this yet but the board should consider having a public hearing about this if it moves forward.
  - Lance Achterberg recaps that the storm damage cleanup was finished in 2020 and the cost was reimbursed by FEMA.
