Regular Town Board Meeting

Called to Order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Lance Achterberg

- Motion by Larry, seconded by Vikki to approve the minutes of the February 8, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.
- Clerk's Report given.
- Treasurer's report read.
- **Library Report:** Master Gardeners dropped off native WI seeds along with instructions and containers for winter sowing. The County Health Department would like to do a vaccine clinic at the town hall, Judi will contact the department for more information. The filter light is on on the drinking fountain and the sink in the mens restroom is leaking.
- **Citizens Inquiries and Concerns:** None
- **Fire District:** Meeting is next month
- **Recycling Center:** New resident stickers will be ordered for the first time as some of the old ones are starting to fade. Motion by Vikki, seconded by Larry that Judi ask the Buffalo Lake District if the town can use their property to set up a second recycling center if needed. Motion carried. Lance will also talk to waste management about getting a garbage dumpster.
- **Roads:** Vikki and Judi are scheduling the road trip with Brian.
- **Town Hall, Park, Flags, Boat Landings, Christmas Decorations:**
 - Town Signs - Shawna contacted Vikki as no one gave her the fourth piece of plywood. Shawna will just pick it up herself. Posts will need to be checked to see if they need to be replaced.
 - Pavilion Kitchen Cleaning - Larry will make sure Kathy cleans it prior to the first rental of the year.
 - Larry talked with an electrician about the outdoor lights but has not received a quote yet.
 - Larry looked into redoing the Christmas decorations and he can order 24.5 foot outdoor LED strings with 50 lights for \$18-20. He would like to order a couple and redo a single fixture to see how it goes.
- **Lake Commission Reports:**
 - Buffalo: Meeting coming up.
 - Emery: Meeting in two weeks
 - Williams: No report.
- **Firewise:** Received grant for trimming driveways. There is a meeting at Call of the Wild in May.
- **Old Business:**
 - Veterans Memorial Project: No update.
 - Speed on 11th Dr.: Vikki is waiting to hear from Brian, she will call him to follow up.
 - Wisconsin to Church St Alleyway Vacation: Jesse recommends getting the Plan Commission involved. Lance will get the plat from the county. There are approximately six property owners that border the alley. Lance will discuss this with John Blumke and Jesse will draft two resolutions.
 - Audit/Review: Kerber and Rose are willing to do the review. Judi will forward the contact information to Courtney and she will reach out to them.
- **New Business:**
 - Unowned lot on Chestnut Street: Per Tom Onofrey anyone can go through the Court and have that property become theirs - the town or an individual. Lance will let the Burkhardt's know it's available if they want to pay the Court costs for it.
