Pledge of Allegiance

Meeting was held due to the recent storm on August 28, 2018. It was reported that this storm involved tornados, straight line winds and micro bursts. The worst of this storm in Packwaukee hit hard on the south side of the Causeway, on Freedom Drive, Freedom Court, Lakeview Drive, Lakeshore Drive and all surrounding roads nearby these.

Due to the recent Tornado/High Winds – what is the responsibility of the Town to pick up downed trees, branches and other debris along the roads in the Town of Packwaukee.

Fema money – for town expenses.. The Town would have to spend the money to get the money back.

The Sheriff Department, County Highway Department and EMS will bill the Town because their services were on Town roads.

It was brought up by Linda Higgert that many of the property owners didn't have a way to haul brush because they don't own a truck or a trailer and because most of the damage was on Lake District member's property that maybe the Lake District/Association would help by using their dump trucks for clean-up. Lonnie Ayotte and C.J. from Countryside Salvage asked if it would be possible to use the Lake District/Association property for a brush pile adding that the recycling center probably would not hold all the brush that there is out there, and then it could be burnt in the winter.

Because there is so much to decide about this storm clean-up a motion by Lance Acterberg seconded by Joe Oravetz to table any action on the storm damage until the next Town Board Meeting on September 11th at 6:00 p.m. at the Packwaukee Town Hall. Motion Carried.
