Regular Town Board Meeting Minutes

In attendance: Lance Achterberg, Vikki Trimble, Judi Nigbor, Keith Bagley, Larry Haygood, Courtney Trimble - Clerk, Jeri Showers - Treasurer

- Motion by Vikki, seconded by Larry to approve the minutes from the Town Board meeting of December 10, 2019. Motion carried.
- Clerks Report: Ballot placement for April Election were drawn as follows: 1 - Janny Slama, 2 - Vikki Trimble, 3 - Larry Haygood.
- Treasurer's report was read.
- Library Report: Carol would like to put a bulletin board on the wall by the front doors to get some of the stuff off the doors. Carol is also going to sell the yellow bookcase in the meeting room to another library because it doesn't fit in the library and she would like to purchase a storage cabinet to take its place. Motion by Vikki, seconded by Keith to allow the bulletin board and cabinet. Motion carried. Vista Care is having a hiring event on Jan. 27th.
- Citizens Concerns:
 - Billboard on CX by the train bridge is in bad shape. That property is privately owned and in Oxford. Nothing the town can do.
 - How is FEMA cleanup going? County is working on it. The ground is still soft which is making it difficult.
 - Lance got a call from Gary Burckhardt about whether or not there was an ordinance regarding chickens. He has ducks and wants to know if the town would be willing to make a special exception to any no-livestock rule to allow chickens and ducks. This will be put on the agenda for February.
- Feedback on previous citizen concerns:
 - The junk car is off the road on County D in town.
 - Keith was able to get the generator running. Got a quote from Wolter for maintenance. Will need to allocate money for a new battery.
 - Dennis Hurckman has been calling Judi about the trees in his yard that he thinks are in the right of way. This will be put on the agenda in February.
 - Judy received a call from the DNR regarding Lake Emery boat landing. Ice fisherman have been parking in the lot and getting notes on his window about not paying the launch fee. Vikki will check with Lake Emery about whether or not this person is paying.
 - Judi received multiple calls regarding the recycling center parking lot being too slippery. She would like to put a pile or two of salt/sand at the dump for use at the dump and for citizens to take. Per Lance there are containers out there that are supposed to have sand in them that is used for the lot. This system has worked fine the past 3 years and for some reason it was just not done this year.
- An update was given on the Ice Age Trail that runs through Marquette County.

- A new contract was received regarding the Senior Dining Site. Jeri will look back to see when the last time was we were paid. The town is supposed to be billing the county but no one knows how long it's been since we were paid. Motion by Larry, seconded by Keith to approve the senior dining site contract. Motion carried.
 - Town hall, Park, Flags, Boat Landings, Christmas Decorations:
 - Keith is questioning the bad condition of the pavilion. The town first needs to look at the structural integrity of the existing structure before deciding how to move forward. Keith thinks he may be able to get the Historic Society to chip in to get it fixed or replaced. Keith will get a quote on repairs.
 - Town hall front door: Original door came in damaged and was shipped back. The new one should be here next week.
 - Land Use Planning Commission: Mast Property - This plan was approved by the plan commission based on a contingency. Motion by Vikkie, seconded by Larry to accept the plan commission recommendation.
 - Lake Commission Reports: Nothing to report.
 - Firewise program: Al and Lance are working on getting this years program together. This is on hold until the cleanup is finished. Friday at 2pm there is a firewise meeting.
 - Old Business:
 - FEMA Report - This was discussed earlier in the meeting.
 - New Business: The day of this meeting a claim was received from Gustav Totsky demanding the replacement of the culvert on his property. This will be forwarded to the town attorney.
